<p>Globalization is a term that we use and hear frequently in our daily life. But what is globalization? Is it a hegemonic script? Is it an on-going process? Is globalization a gender-neutral term? In this class, we will learn how our local everyday lives are (re)shape by globalization and are connected to the things happened beyond our daily scope.</p> <p>In this class, we first look at some of the major topics and debates pertaining to the expanding literature on globalization in sociology and anthropology, then link the topic of globalization with that of migration to highlight its major contradictions. The second portion of the course focuses specifically on East and Southeast Asia as sending and receiving region for migration and explores an intersection of issues pertaining to global changes in this region.</p>
