課程目標 Course Objectives					
除介紹若干歷史記憶研究的理論與概念外，本課程透過每週由授課教師自編英文讀本(包括學術論文、一手史料、圖像)與影片之閱讀與分析，以個案研究引導學生探究與思考歐美、中國、台灣與東南亞有關殖民統治、戰爭創傷與極權專制的歷史記憶，如何成為各區域社會集體建構其國家或族群認同與政治主張的合理性工具。此外，教師亦選擇適當的紀錄片與影片作為輔助教材，促進學生之思考與問題之提出。最後，由學生進行個案研究，並撰寫期末論文，以具體實踐於本學期所學之歷史記憶相關概念與理論。
