<p>This course aims to explore the influence of Asia-Pacific region in shaping global politics. In addition to focusing on the actorness of nation state, it further adopts the approach to treat regional actor as an analysis unit and explore the actorness of region in shaping both the global and regional order. To help student understand the current regional issues through inter-regionalist channel and strengthen students' capabilities to conduct transnational political, economic, social and cultural academic research.</p> <p>With this course, it aims to develop students' theoretical knowledge and analytical skill to study world politics with influence of globalization, inter-regional relations, with particular focus on Asia-Pacific.</p> <p>After this course, it expects students to cultivate capabilities of</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 課程大綱

Course Outline

In this course, the rise of Asia in global politics will be the main focus for students to examine the challenges and opportunities presented by Asia-Pacific region from political, economic, and social perspectives. The course will start with examining global evolving system, the phenomenon of globalization and the idea of global governance. Then, going beyond conventional Asian area studies, this course will take Asia-Pacific as a region and delve deeper into Asia's growing interactions with different world regions, including Africa, Latin America, and Europe. Here the idea of inter-regionalism will be introduced to explore the phenomenon of interregionalism in the world politics. It discusses the interregional relations between Asia and others. Main topics will include the "Asian values" debate, trans-regional integration in the Asia-Pacific, Asian regional organizations (e.g. the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank), the rivalry between China and the United States in the Indo-Pacific, and the "uber-nationalism" of Chinese President Xi Jinping, to list a few.

Emphasis will be placed on the role of both the major powers in the region, such as China, India, Japan, South Korea, ASEAN, the US, but also the influential regional entity in the international sphere, such as EU.

All in all, it explores Asia's role in global politics and meanwhile the influence 'inter-regional relations' in shaping the regional order in Asia Pacific.
